Repair, Restore, & Reuse

Keeping the thingumajigs, doofas & whatsits.

Giving new life to items that will otherwise be wasted to the landfill, we save anything we can repair, restore, reuse or even upcycle, creating wonders out of waste.

Recycle.

Anything we can't fix upcycle or reuse, we recycle. A lot of our recycling is electrical waste (E-waste), including TV's, washing machines, computers, mowers, bikes, stereos, tools and all sorts of funky doodads.

Our destroyers dismantle waste and recycle Steels, Copper, Aluminium, Electrical Wiring, and all kinds of other bits and bobs to save it from going to landfill.

School Tours

We form part of the World Of Waste Tour, bringing young people through various sites in the Hutt that play part in minimising waste in our communities.



Wellness & Work Skills Training

Our 10 week training programme is 2 days a week. 2 weeks of classroom activities focusing on health, safety and personal wellness in the workplace.

This is followed by work based learning, mentoring and on the job support in Earthlink's various units, including:
