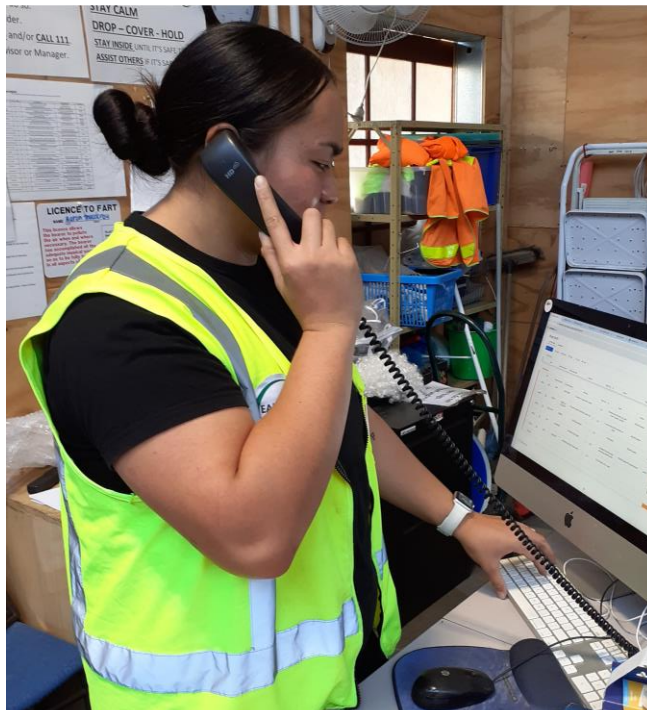

Work Skills Programme

Our 6 week training program is two days per week. It consists of classroom activities for a few days, focusing on health & safety, employment and wellbeing. (No literacy skills required for the classroom.) This is followed by two days a week for 5 weeks practical work based learning, mentoring and on-the-job support in Earthlink’s various units, including:

- Furniture repair
- Retail
- Small motors
- Stock prep
- Dismantling
- Recycling runs
- Bike repairs
- Inwards Goods

We'll help you identify your employment interests and map your goals to achieving it. We aim to make our programme effective and fun for those seeking to engage in the community.

*Our work-based program is hands on training with one-to-one mentoring.



*Working with your interests, together, we will build a work profile and career plan.

*If you need additional training to achieve your goal, we can help you to choose where to go next.

*We can connect you with other agencies for support in other areas you would benefit from.

*We often facilitating meetings to collaborate multiple agencies that should or could be involved in effective support.
